## JOINT RESOLUTION

Requesting a study of boarding facilities for the high schools at Kotzebue, Unalakleet and Barrow.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Bureau of Indian Affairs is exercising its education responsibilities at Kotzebue, Unalakleet and Barrow through the construction of high schools; and

WHEREAS Kotzebue, Unalakleet and Barrow, upon the completion of the high schools, will attract students from the general area who could not otherwise receive a high school education in their villages; and

WHEREAS the influx of students from the areas served will require boarding facilities to be built in connection with the Bureau of Indian Affairs high schools;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature requests the Bureau of Indian Affairs to study the need for boarding facilities at Kotzebue, Unalakleet and Barrow in conjunction with the new high schools at those locations so that students from the surrounding areas may also have an opportunity for a high school education.

COPIES of this resolution shall be sent to the Honorable Stewart L. Udall, Secretary of the Interior; the Honorable Robert L. Bennett, Commissioner of Indian Affairs; and to the Honorable E. L. Bartlett and the Honorable Ernest Gruening, U. S. Senators, and the Honorable Ralph J. Rivers, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
