HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 10

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to the paving of the
Lunch Creek and Beaver Falls
extensions of the Tongass
Highway.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS the Tongass Highway is the only major highway in the Ketchikan area; and

WHEREAS the Lunch Creek extension of the North Tongass Highway provides access to a camping and picnic complex, recently developed by the Forest Service, which is a prime tourist attraction; and

WHEREAS the Beaver Falls extension of the South Tongass Highway provides access to the municipal power works as well as to recreational and timber areas; and

WHEREAS both the Lunch Creek and Beaver Falls extensions also serve rapidly-growing residential areas; and

WHEREAS the present and projected traffic loads on these roadways make it necessary that these extensions be paved as soon as possible;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Department of Highways is requested to include the paving of the Lunch Creek and Beaver Falls extensions of the Tongass Highway in its five-year program for secondary road system improvements.
