HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 11

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to the most recent
victory of the Ketchikan Kayhi
Kings.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS the Fairbanks Lathrop Malemutes, western Alaska basketball champions have met the Ketchikan Kayhi Kings, the southeast Alaska champions, to compete for the state basketball title; and

WHEREAS the Ketchikan Kayhi Kings defeated the Fairbanks Lathrop Malemutes this past weekend in a three-game competition, thus winning the 1966 state basketball crown; and

WHEREAS this is the second consecutive year that the state basketball championship has been won by the Ketchikan team;
