HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 12

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Requesting the pavement of South
Arctic Boulevard to alleviate
commuter traffic congestion in
the Greater Anchorage area.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS commuter traffic congestion is one of the most serious problems of the Greater Anchorage area; and

WHEREAS the problems of heavy commuter traffic are particularly evident on South Arctic Boulevard, also known as Campbell Station Road; and

WHEREAS to alleviate this growing traffic problem it is essential that the route be paved at the earliest possible time;

BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives respectfully requests the Governor to direct the Department of Highways to pave South Arctic Boulevard, also known as the Campbell Station Road, from the Northern Commercial Cat Company through to Sand Lake Road during the 1966 construction season.
