HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 14

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to state and industry
cooperation in the construction
and use of tanker docking
facilities on the western shore
of Cook Inlet.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS the petroleum industry operating in the Cook Inlet area oil fields has announced plans for the construction of a petroleum tanker port; and

WHEREAS the proposed docking facility will be located on the west side of Cook Inlet in the vicinity of Kalgin Island; and

WHEREAS the southwest Alaska state ferry system operates in Cook Inlet and the possibility of beneficial cooperation between the state and the petroleum industry in developing the western shore of Cook Inlet is suggested;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct the Department of Public Works to explore the possibility of cooperation with the petroleum interests which plan to construct a tanker docking facility on the western shore of Cook Inlet to the end that the docking facility could be constructed to accommodate the state ferry operating in the area with benefits accruing to industry and the state through the development of auxiliary facilities and promoting access to and development of the area west of Cook Inlet.
