HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 6

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to representation on
the Board of Governors of the
Alaska Bar Association by an
attorney practicing in the
Second Judicial District.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS the Alaska Bar Association was created by the Alaska State Legislature; and

WHEREAS the membership of the Alaska Bar Association is made up of the qualified and licensed attorneys of the State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS the internal operations of the Alaska Bar Association are managed by a nine-man Board of Governors elected by the members of the association; and

WHEREAS at the annual Convention of the Alaska Bar Association held at Fairbanks, Alaska, in May of 1963, the membership of the association passed certain resolutions governing the operation of their association; and

WHEREAS Resolution No. 27 of that convention called for one member of the Board of Governors to be elected every nine years, for a term of three years, from among those attorneys practicing in the Second Judicial District; and

WHEREAS the said resolution was to take effect with the election of May, 1964; and

WHEREAS the Board of Governors of the Alaska Bar Association

saw fit not to comply with the mandate of its members;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Governors of the Alaska Bar Association is urged to implement the provisions of Alaska Bar Association Resolution No. 27 beginning with the election of May, 1966; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Governors of the Alaska Bar Association is directed to report to the House of Representatives of the Alaska State Legislature within 30 days of the First Session of the Fifth State Legislature as to its compliance herewith.

COPIES of this resolution shall be sent to the president and members of the Board of Governors of the Alaska Bar Association.
