SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 10

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to a cold storage
system for Golovin, Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the village of Golovin is situated in a remote area of the state; and

WHEREAS there are available to the people of Golovin abundant supplies of fish and reindeer; and

WHEREAS further development of these two valuable natural resources would greatly enhance the economy of Golovin and the surrounding area and provide, at the same time, additional supplies of food for the residents of the area; and

WHEREAS the village of Golovin is not able to exploit the natural resources of fish and reindeer to the greatest possible advantage for the community because of the lack of an adequate cold storage system; and

WHEREAS a community cold storage facility would not only greatly benefit Golovin and the surrounding vicinity economically, but would aid in the future development of that area of the state;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Departments of Labor, Economic Development and Planning and the Rural Development Agency are urgently requested to assist, by any means at their disposal, in the establishment of a community cold storage and freezer system for fish and reindeer in Golovin.
