SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 23

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Nominating Don Sheldon of Talkeetna  
for the state medal for heroism.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Governor is authorized by law to award the state medal for heroism to citizens of the State of Alaska in recognition of heroism in saving lives; and

WHEREAS Don Sheldon of Talkeetna has made numerous perilous landings in his plane on the icy slopes and surfaces of mountains and glaciers of the Alaskan Range to rescue injured persons and bring them to safety for immediate medical attention; and

WHEREAS Don Sheldon has for many years always responded to any emergency call for assistance without regard to the personal risks involved and without any thought for monetary gain for himself;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature submits to the Governor the name of Don Sheldon of Talkeetna as a nominee for the awarding of the state medal for heroism in recognition of his years of meritorious and unselfish service on the behalf of those in peril.
