Honoring Miss Kathy Shapley
of Craig for her design for
the State Medal of Heroism.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Legislature in 1965 authorized the issuance of a medal by the Governor to persons performing heroic service on behalf of the health, welfare and safety of others; and

WHEREAS pursuant to the legislative mandate Governor William A. Egan directed the conduct of a competitive effort among the school children of the state for a design for the State Medal of Heroism; and

WHEREAS from 429 entries the Governor's committee selected the design submitted by Kathy Shapley of Craig, a gold medal featuring helping hands suspended from a blue ribbon with the Big Dipper and the North Star in gold on it;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska extends to Kathy Shapley of Craig its heartiest congratulations for her award winning design for the State Medal of Heroism and expresses the thanks of the State of Alaska for her outstanding work along with best wishes for the future development of her creative talent.
