SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 29

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Requesting navigational aids for
state-owned trunk airports.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS in many areas of the state the only type of airport available is a trunk airport constructed by the state; and

WHEREAS the general absence of navigational aids at trunk airports makes these airports unusable in bad weather and dangerous to attempt to land on in marginal weather; and

WHEREAS the installation of non-directional beacons at the trunk airports would make possible the more safe and frequent use of the airports;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct the Department of Public Works to install non-directional beacons at all state-owned trunk airports at the earliest possible time.
