SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 34

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Approving in prospect the sub-
leasing by the Cities of Nome,
Cordova, and Unalaska from the
State of Alaska of certain public
buildings.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Legislature has approved Senate Bill No. 198,
as amended by the Conference Committee, and the bill has now been
returned to the Governor for signature; and

WHEREAS under the provisions of the bill a political sub-
division of the state, upon meeting certain conditions, may
sublease from the State of Alaska public buildings financed, de-
signed, constructed, and acquired by the Alaska State Housing
Authority and leased to the State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS one of the requisites for eligibility of a political
subdivision of the state is the passage by the Legislature of a
concurrent resolution approving the sublease or lease;

BE IT RESOLVED that, subject to the fulfillment of the other
conditions set forth in Senate Bill No. 198, amended, as further
amended in the Conference Committee Report adopted by the Legis-
lature, the Legislature hereby gives its approval to subleases
between the State of Alaska and the following political subdi-
visions of the state for the following projects if leased by the
State of Alaska from the Alaska State Housing Authority, provided
that the projects do not exceed the amounts specified below:

City of Nome	High School and/or Elementary School	\$2,500,000
City of Cordova	High School	1,500,000
City of Unalaska	Combined Elementary and High School	750,000

COPIES of this resolution shall be sent to the Commissioner of Commerce and the governing bodies of the Cities of Nome, Cordova, and Unalaska.
