SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 5

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to the death of the
Honorable B. Frank Heintzleman.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS since the last meeting of the Fourth Legislature the Honorable B. Frank Heintzleman has been taken in death; and

WHEREAS Governor Heintzleman was a particularly able and distinguished Alaskan who for over 50 years contributed immeasurably to economic life of the territory and state; and

WHEREAS he began his Alaskan service in 1918 with the U. S. Forest Service and served as Regional Forester for Alaska from 1937 until 1953; and

WHEREAS in 1953 the President of the United States appointed B. Frank Heintzleman Governor of the Territory of Alaska and he served ably and productively in that position until January 1957; and

WHEREAS in his retirement from official public service he continued until the moment of his death to serve his adopted state in an energetic private capacity to further the economic development of Alaska;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska does by this resolution express its highest esteem for former Governor B. Frank Heintzleman as a private person and a public servant in whose debt the State of Alaska is honored to be, and to express on behalf of the people of the state its sincerest condolences to his sister, Mrs. Ava P. Grove of Fayetteville,

Pennsylvania, assuring her that his memory will ever shine bright in the history of Alaska.
