JOINT RESOLUTION

Requesting navigational aids for the entrance to the Kasilof River.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS boat owners using the entrance to the Kasilof River have petitioned the 17th Coast Guard District for navigational aids; and

WHEREAS the lack of navigational aids has caused great damage and threatened lives of persons trying to navigate in those dangerous waters but the requested aids have not been installed; and

WHEREAS the Kenai Peninsula Fishermen's Cooperative Association has endorsed the installation of navigational aids as necessary to the economy of the area and those using those waters;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Commandant, U. S. Coast Guard, is respectfully and earnestly urged to direct the 17th Coast Guard District to install necessary navigational aids at the entrance to the Kasilof River.
