SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 10

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Requesting a survey of the
feasibility of constructing an
access road between Cordova and
Orca.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS the construction of about four miles of access road to Orca from Cordova would provide access to the cannery located there; and

WHEREAS if a road connection were available it would then be possible to employ approximately 40 employees who could commute to and from work; and

WHEREAS the land involved is scheduled to come under state control and it appears that an access road could be constructed with some ease and little expense along the beachline between Cordova and Orca;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to direct the Department of Highways to make a survey as to the feasibility and cost of constructing an access road between Cordova and the Orca cannery.
