SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 12

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to the construction of an
oil pipeline from the Port of
Whittier to Elmendorf Air Force Base.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS the conflict in Viet Nam has again illustrated the need for maintaining an efficient, up-to-date military air supply system to the Pacific via Alaska; and

WHEREAS Elmendorf Air Force Base is a vital refueling stop in this military air supply system; and

WHEREAS the fuel demands at Elmendorf are likely to become greater than the present storage and transportation facilities can provide;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Senate supports the military proposal to construct an oil pipeline from the Port of Whittier to Elmendorf Air Force Base.
