SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 15

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Expressing support for the
Alaska delegation appearing
before Congress on Alaska
native housing legislation.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS the Congress now has before it S. 1915, a bill authorizing a housing program for Alaska natives sponsored by the Honorable E. L. Bartlett, senior U. S. Senator from Alaska; and

WHEREAS S. 1915 would establish a loan and grant housing program specifically designed for Alaska's remote villages and thus fulfill a desperate need for village housing without parallel in the nation; and

WHEREAS a delegation of Alaskans will be in Washington, D. C. to testify in support of this vital legislation before the Housing Subcommittee of the Senate Banking and Currency Committee;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of the State of Alaska expresses its full support for the delegation of Alaskans appearing before Congress on behalf of S. 1915, a bill authorizing a desperately needed housing program for Alaskan natives, and urges that S. 1915 receive the expeditious approval of Congress.
