SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 22

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Congratulating the Cities of
Anchorage, Seward and Valdez as
All-American Cities for 1966.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS three Alaskan cities have been accorded national honors by being designated All-American Cities for 1966; and

WHEREAS the designation includes a special recognition of the efforts of the citizens and governments of those cities to improve and expand their status and services; and

WHEREAS all three cities incurred devastating damage as a result of the earthquake and seismic wave of March 27, 1964, and through prodigious efforts survived the disaster and came forth as improved communities; and

WHEREAS this is the second time that the City of Anchorage and the City of Seward have been so honored;

BE IT RESOLVED that the citizens and governments of the Cities of Anchorage, Seward and Valdez are extended the sincerest congratulations and best wishes of the Senate of the Alaska State Legislature on the occasion of their designation as All-American Cities for 1966.
