SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 7

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to electrical service  
for the Mud Bay Road area near  
Haines, Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS electrical energy is a basic requirement for the maintenance of homes and the services of industry; and

WHEREAS the residents of the Mud Bay Road area near Haines, Alaska, do not now have the basic light and power needs; and

WHEREAS this area is in need of electrical transmission facilities to supply basic domestic needs as well as to provide additional electrical power for the operation of a cannery and future industrial development;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Rural Electrification Administration is requested to confer with the Haines Light and Power Company on the feasibility of extending electrical service to the Mud Bay Road area to provide sufficient power for domestic needs and industrial development in that area.
