SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 9

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Directing the construction of a highway from Savonoski to King Salmon to develop the tourism potential of the Bristol Bay area.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS the general area of Bristol Bay has a great potential for attracting tourists and those who enjoy hunting and fishing; and

WHEREAS the development of this potential is dependent upon the increase of tourist access to the region; and

WHEREAS a road across the Alaska Peninsula connecting Katmai and King Salmon and linking up with the ferry service to and from Kodiak Island provided by the M/V TUSTUMENA is the most feasible way to open up the area to tourism and basic economic development; and

WHEREAS there is already a road connection towards King Salmon extending from Katmai to Savonoski;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Department of Highways is directed to construct a road from Savonoski to King Salmon thus providing a road across the Alaska Peninsula which will make possible the development of the great tourism potential of the Bristol Bay area.
