AN ACT

Extending cost of living allowances to certain retired public employees; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 39.35.480 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(d) A public employee of the Territory of Alaska who participated in the public employees retirement act established by ch. 41, SIA 1949, and who retired before the effective date of ch. 102, SIA 1951, is entitled to the cost of living allowance equal to 25 per cent of the amount received under ch. 41, SIA 1949, if he still resides in, and for as long as he continues to reside in, the state.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
