AN ACT

Relating to the penalty for driving, towing away or taking a vehicle without the consent of the owner or being a party, accessory or accomplice thereto.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 28.35.010(a) is amended to read:

(a) A person who drives, tows away, or takes a vehicle not his own without the consent of the owner, with intent temporarily to deprive the owner of possession of the vehicle, or a person who is a party or accessory to or an accomplice in the driving or unauthorized taking is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction is punishable by imprisonment for not less than 30 days nor more than one year, and by a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000. The consent of the owner of a vehicle to its driving, towing away, or taking shall not be presumed or implied because of the owner's consent on previous occasions to the driving, towing away or taking of the vehicle by the same or a different person.
