AN ACT

Relating to penalties for violations of municipal ordinances which govern the barter, sale and possession of intoxicating liquor.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 04.15.070 is amended to read:

Sec. 04.15.070. MUNICIPAL REGULATIONS. (a) An incorporated municipality may by ordinance provide rules and regulations governing the barter, sale and possession of intoxicating liquor within the municipality necessary to the orderly conduct of the business of selling intoxicating liquor. The ordinance shall not be inconsistent with this title or the rules and regulations promulgated under this title. No municipality may impose taxes other than property taxes on liquor inventories and sales taxes on liquor sales when these taxes are levied on other property and sales within the municipality.

(b) The provisions of sec. 100(b) of this chapter relating to penalties for violation of this title apply also with respect to penalties for violation of municipal ordinances adopted under the authority of (a) of this section.
