AN ACT

Changing the average daily membership allotment in the public school foundation program.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 14.17.060(a) is amended to read:

(a) The average daily membership allotment for each district is as follows:

(1) if the district is in the Southeastern Senate District: \$155 times average daily membership;

(2) if the district is in the Southcentral Senate District: \$165 times average daily membership;

(3) if the district is in the Central and Northwest Senate Districts and that part of the Southcentral Senate District lying west 152° west longitude: \$175 times the average daily attendance.

* Sec. 2. AS 14.17 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 14.17.075. SUPPLEMENTAL ALLOCATION. (a) In addition to the amounts authorized to be paid to school districts under this chapter, a supplemental allocation equivalent to \$15 per pupil in total average daily membership for the purpose of further equalization of disparities due to size and availability of local resources may be made. These allocations shall be distributed on the basis of average daily membership in the inverse ratio that each district's total equivalent evaluation per pupil bears to the average equivalent evaluation per pupil. However, for a district whose total equivalent evaluation per pupil is below the average, and whose average daily

membership is below 600, the allocation may be increased by 10 per cent for each unit of 100 by which the district average daily membership, rounded to the nearest 100, is less than 600, provided that the district makes a local contribution of not less than that which would be raised by a 10-mill levy.

(b) For purposes of computing allocations under this section, total equivalent evaluation per pupil is the sum of the amount that 50 per cent of the P.L. 874 entitlement would represent as the base of a 10-mill levy and the evaluation of the district, divided by the average daily membership. The reports of the public school foundation program shall be used in applying this program.

(c) The commissioner shall make adjustments necessary to insure that no district receives less than \$15 per pupil in ADM under this section when increased payments to the district from state tuition over the prior year are considered.
