## AN ACT

Relating to the Social Security Amendments of 1967; and providing for an effective date.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 23.15 is amended by adding new sections to read:

#### ARTICLE 5. WORK INCENTIVE PROGRAM FOR WELFARE RECIPIENTS.

Sec. 23.15.650. PARTICIPATION IN WORK INCENTIVE PROGRAM FOR WELFARE RECIPIENTS. In order to provide those receiving aid to families with dependent children with incentives, opportunities, and necessary services for employment, training and participation in the regular economy the Department of Labor is authorized to administer the Work Incentive Program for Welfare Recipients. This authorization includes authority to execute on behalf of the state agreements or contracts with the appropriate federal agencies containing provisions which may be necessary or desirable to enable the state to participate in the program to receive and expend all appropriate funds made available for the program by the state or by the federal government, to supervise the expenditures of the funds and the conduct of the program, and to make reports and certificates which are called for, and otherwise to cooperate with the federal government and its departments and agencies in the administration of the program.

\* Sec. 2. AS 47.25.310 is amended to read:

Sec. 47.25.310. ELIGIBILITY FOR ASSISTANCE. The department shall grant assistance to the family of each dependent child it determines is eligible for assistance

under secs. 310 - 420 of this chapter, or to employers under a work incentive program established by AS 23.15.620, and by sec. 433(E)(1) of the Federal Social Security Act of 1967 as amended.

\* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
