AN ACT

Relating to limitation of benefits under the fishermen's fund.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 23.35.140 is amended to read:

Sec. 23.35.140. LIMITATION ON BENEFITS. The total allowance for any one heart attack is \$2,500. Except for compelling reasons,

(1) no compensation may be paid for medical care or hospitalization furnished before the ascertainable time of injury, or before authorization in the case of disability caused by an occupational disease;

(2) the total allowance for any one injury or disablement is \$2,500.
