AN ACT

Relating to public utilities.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 42.05.640(2) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

(2) "public utility" or "utility" includes every corporation, whether public, cooperative, or otherwise, company, individual, or association of individuals, their lessees, trustees, or receivers appointed by a court, that owns, operates, manages, or controls any plant, pipeline, or system for

(A) the generation, transmission, or distribution of electric energy and power, or the furnishing of telephone or telegraph communications, any of which produce an annual gross income in excess of \$25,000;

(B) the distribution to the public for compensation of heat, natural or manufactured gas; or

(C) the furnishing to the public for compensation of water, or petroleum or petroleum products by pipeline, or community sewer services;

* Sec. 2. AS 42.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 42.05.645. APPLICATION OF CHAPTER. This chapter does not apply to

(1) a person who furnishes water or petroleum or petroleum products by tank, wagon, or similar conveyance;

(2) a municipally owned and operated utility;

(3) a person engaged in the production or gathering of natural gas or petroleum, or to the plant, pipeline, or system used for these purposes;

(4) a person engaged in the distribution of natural or manufactured gas or petroleum or petroleum products to industrial customers only and not to the public generally, or to the plant, pipeline, or system used for these purposes;

(5) the plant, pipeline, or system used for the distribution of any concentrate or liquid substance by the owner or operator thereof used solely for transportation.
