## AN ACT

Providing for the issuance of licenses for certain vehicles used only occasionally upon highways.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 28.10.040 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

(5) a motor vehicle used in relation to fishing, mining, hunting or farming operations and which is used only occasionally upon a highway, and for which a license has been issued under sec. 127 of this chapter.

\* Sec. 2. AS 28.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 28.10.127. LICENSES FOR OCCASIONAL USERS OF HIGHWAYS. (a) Upon application by the owner and under regulations adopted by the commissioner of revenue, the department shall issue a license to the owner of a vehicle used in relation to fishing, mining, hunting, or farming operations and used only occasionally upon a highway.

(b) The license shall be valid for 12 months.

(c) No person may possess more than two licenses at one time.

(d) The department shall charge the owner a fee of \$15 for the issuance of a license.
