AN ACT

Relating to disposition of state land in certain situations of hardship or injustice; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 38.05.035(b) is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

(5) when he determines it is in the best interest of the state and will avoid injustice to a person, dispose of land by direct negotiation to that person who presently uses and who used and made improvements to that land before January 3, 1959; the amount paid for the land shall be its fair market value as of that date, as determined by the director; a parcel of land disposed of under this paragraph shall be of a size consistent with the person's prior use, but may not exceed five acres.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
