## AN ACT

Relating to rewards for persons providing information leading to arrest and conviction of narcotic peddlers.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 17.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 17.10.212. REWARD. (a) A person providing information which leads to the arrest and conviction of another on the charge of unlawfully selling narcotic drugs to a minor is eligible for a reward of \$1,000.

(b) The district attorney in the judicial district where the prosecution for the unlawful sale of the narcotic drug takes place shall determine if the person requesting the reward is entitled to it under this section. If the district attorney determines that the person is eligible to receive the reward he shall promptly file a certification to this effect with the Department of Public Safety. Upon receiving certification the Department of Public Safety shall pay the reward from appropriations made to that department for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this section.
