AN ACT

Relating to authorizing the Department of Administration to make expenditures to meet extraordinary expenditures of boroughs, cities, municipal utility systems and school districts incurred as a result of the natural disaster of August 14, 1967; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. The Department of Administration is authorized to make expenditures of \$1,276,000 or such part as is necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act, for extraordinary expenditures of boroughs, cities, municipal utility systems and school districts in that area of the state declared a natural disaster area by President Johnson's proclamation of August 17, 1967, where the extraordinary expenses were incurred as a direct result of the natural disaster.

* Sec. 2. No funds may be disbursed under this Act until the borough, city, municipal utility system or school district qualifying for the funds has applied to the department in the manner to be prescribed by the department. Boroughs, cities, municipal utility systems and school districts receiving funds under this Act shall account to the department for the expenditures of the funds.

* Sec. 3. The department shall not authorize any expenditures under this Act after June 30, 1969.

* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
