AN ACT

Authorizing the implementation of the Alaska Native Housing Program; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. In anticipation of a federal appropriation of \$10,000,000 to the people of Alaska by the federal government under Title 10, Section 1004, Public Law 89-754, 80 Stat. 1285 (1966), the Department of Administration is authorized to make available to the agency designated by the Governor under ch. 93, SLA 1967, the sum of \$1,000,000 as the state's share in financing the cost of preparing, administering and implementing the Alaska Native Housing Program authorized by Title 10, Section 1004, Public Law 89-754, 80 Stat. 1285(1966) and implemented by ch. 93, SLA 1967. However, if less than \$10,000,000 is granted to the people of Alaska by the federal government under said program, the portion of state funds to be made available by the Department of Administration under this Act shall be reduced by the same percentage as the amount of federal funds given differs from the \$10,000,000 authorized.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1968.
