AN ACT

Making certain appropriations for claims arising from prior years; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. The sum of \$62.39 is appropriated from the general fund for payment to H.J. McKirdy for adjusted terminal leave pay accrued in 1961.

* Sec. 2. The sum of \$150 is appropriated to pay James Thomas Keenan, beneficiary of Margaret HARRAIS, for final teachers' retirement payment for March, 1964:

From general fund	\$ 50.00
From teachers' retirement fund	100.00

* Sec. 3. The sum of \$553.18 is appropriated from the general fund to pay the estate of Claude A. Demoski, deceased, final salary benefits earned during September, 1960.

* Sec. 4. The sum of \$180 is appropriated from the fish and game funds to reimburse the following persons for loss of personally owned equipment due to accidents while on official state business:

To Ronald Somerville	\$140.00
To Fred T. Williams	40.00

* Sec. 5. The sum of \$232.28 is appropriated from the general fund to reimburse the following persons for loss of personally owned equipment due to accidents while on official state business:

To James Parker	\$173.00
To Glenn Davenport	59.28

* Sec. 6. The sum of \$3,320.36 is appropriated from the general fund to pay the Automatic Welding and Supply Corporation for work done for the division of aviation in 1964 and 1965.

* Sec. 7. The sum of \$256.24 is appropriated from the general fund to pay the Alaska Packers Association for transporting a drilling rig in April of 1962.

* Sec. 8. The sum of \$44.48 is appropriated from the general fund to pay Alaska School Supply for purchases made in 1963.

* Sec. 9. The sum of \$1,533.44 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Revenue for the purchase of stale date warrants.

* Sec. 10. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
