AN ACT

Relating to the nomination of borough assemblymen from outside cities.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 07.30.050 is amended to read:

Sec. 07.30.050. NOMINATIONS. Candidates for assemblymen from outside cities are nominated by petition of 10 qualified voters of the organized borough who are resident outside any city. Candidates for borough chairman and for the borough school board are nominated by petition of 10 qualified voters of the organized borough.
