AN ACT

Relating to the annual and sick leave of state employees; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 39.20.240 is amended to read:

Sec. 39.20.240. ACCUMULATION OF ANNUAL LEAVE. The annual leave which is not used by an officer or employee accumulates for use in succeeding years until it totals not to exceed 60 days at the end of the calendar year.

* Sec. 2. AS 39.20.260(e) is amended to read:

(e) Upon his separation from state service, and unless he re-enters employment of the state within six months of his termination, the unused sick leave of an officer or employee is automatically cancelled without pay for it. If an employee when terminated by the state re-enters the state service within six months after his termination he is entitled to credit for one half of the sick leave he had accrued at the time of his termination.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
