## AN ACT

Creating an advisory board for the Alaska Pioneers' Homes.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 44.21 is amended by adding new sections to read:

Sec. 44.21.100. ALASKA PIONEERS' HOMES ADVISORY BOARD. There is created the Alaska Pioneers' Homes Advisory Board.

Sec. 44.21.110. PURPOSE OF THE BOARD. The board shall conduct annual inspections of the property and procedures of the Alaska Pioneers' Homes and recommend to the governor changes and improvements. The board will meet on a semi-annual basis to review admissions, procedures and to consider complaints.

Sec. 44.21.120. COMPOSITION OF THE BOARD. The Alaska Pioneers' Homes Advisory Board shall consist of seven members, appointed by the governor from among citizens of Alaska. The members of the board shall serve at the pleasure of the governor.

Sec. 44.21.130. COMPENSATION, PER DIEM, OR EXPENSES. Members of the advisory board receive no salary, but are entitled to per diem and travel expenses authorized by law for other boards.
