AN ACT

Providing for payment of the costs of administering the Homeowners Incentive Act; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. Sec. 1, Ch. 28, FSSSLA 1967 is amended to read:

Sec. 1. (a) The sum of \$1,400,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Commerce for making payments under and administering the incentive payment to the homeowners Act.

(b) Of the sum appropriated under (a) of this section, no more than \$56,000 may be used for the purpose of reimbursing the cost of administering the incentive payments to the homeowners Act.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
