## AN ACT

Relating to spouse's pension and survivor's allowance under the Teachers' Retirement System.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 14.25.055 is amended to read:

Sec. 14.25.055. SUPPLEMENTAL CONTRIBUTION BY A TEACHER. If a teacher is married or has a minor child or minor children and wishes to make his spouse or minor child or minor children eligible for a spouse's pension or survivor's allowance he may make a supplemental contribution of an additional one per cent of his base salary commencing with the second month following his first day of membership in this retirement system, marriage, or November 1, 1967, whichever is later. The contribution shall be deducted by the employer on the basis of days taught at a daily rate determined by dividing the annual contribution by 140.
