AN ACT

Relating to the employment by the Alaska State Ferry System of Canadian citizens; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 39.05.010 is amended to read:

Sec. 39.05.010. EMPLOYMENT OF PERSONS NOT CITIZENS PROHIBITED. It is unlawful for the state or for a city or organized borough in the state to employ a person who is not a citizen of the United States if there is a citizen of the United States possessing equal ability, training, and competence available. The determination of availability, ability, training, and competence shall be made by the governing body of the municipality involved or the director of personnel, Department of Administration. This section does not nullify AS 08.64.200 or 08.64.370, nor does it apply to shore-based employees of the Alaska state ferry system engaged in handling ferry business in Canada.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
