AN ACT

Appropriating to the Department of Health and Welfare; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. The sum of \$50,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Health and Welfare for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968, for the purpose of immediately inaugurating a pilot food stamp program under the Federal Food Stamp Act of 1964 (PL 88-525; 78 Stat. 703; 7 USC 2011 et seq.) with a view toward implementing a full-scale food stamp program in the state by July 1, 1968.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
