AN ACT

Relating to drivers' licenses; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 28.15.050(a) is amended to read:

(a) Every application for an instruction permit or for an operator's license shall be made upon a form furnished by the department and shall be accompanied by the prescribed fee. The fee may not be refunded to the applicant if the license applied for is denied for failure to complete examination requirements of the department within 90 days from date of application for a license. The application shall state the full name, date of birth as proved by a birth certificate or other acceptable proof of age shown to the department, sex and residence address of the applicant, and briefly describe the applicant and shall state whether the applicant has previously been licensed as an operator, and, if so, when and by what licensing authority, and whether a license has ever been suspended, revoked or refused, and, if so, the date of and reason for suspension, revocation or refusal.

* Sec. 2. AS 28.15.080 is amended to read:

Sec. 28.15.080. LICENSES ISSUED TO OPERATORS. Upon payment of the fee prescribed, the department shall issue an operator's license to a qualified applicant. The license shall be sealed in plastic. The license shall contain a distinguishing number assigned to the licensee, the full name, date of birth, address, and a brief description of the licensee, a picture of the licensee or a notation that no facilities were available for picture taking, a space for information as to whom to notify in case of emergency, a space for the name of the licensee's doctor,

a space for a notation of any allergies of the licensee, and either a facsimile of the signature of the licensee or a space upon which the licensee shall write his signature in ink immediately upon receipt of the license. A license is not valid until it is signed by the licensee.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1968.
