AN ACT

Relating to the military grade of the adjutant general.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 26.05.160(a) is amended to read:

(a) The adjutant general of the state is appointed by the governor. The governor shall prescribe the grade of the adjutant general which shall not exceed major general. To be eligible for appointment as adjutant general, a person shall be a citizen of the state. The adjutant general shall make returns and reports to the Chief, National Guard Bureau, and to the governor or to the officers the Chief, National Guard Bureau, and the governor designate, at the times and in the form prescribed.
