AN ACT

Relating to the misbranding of halibut.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 17.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 17.20.045. MISBRANDING HALIBUT. No person may label or offer for sale any food fish product designated as halibut, with or without additional descriptive words, unless the food fish product is Hippoglossus Hippoglossus or Hippoglossus Stenolepsis. A person who violates this section is guilty of misbranding food under provisions of this chapter.
