AN ACT

Relating to removal of vehicles from the state.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 28.10.620 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 28.10.620. REMOVAL OF VEHICLES FROM STATE. A person who removes from the state a vehicle which is the subject of a security interest created under the Alaska Uniform Commercial Code (AS 45.05.690 - 45.05.794) without the written consent of the secured party, and with the intent to defraud the secured party, is guilty of a felony, and upon conviction is punishable by imprisonment for not more than two years, or by a fine of not more than \$2,000 or by both.
