AN ACT

Relating to the suppression of predatory animals in the state; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 16.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:

ARTICLE 4. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS.

Sec. 16.35.200. USE OF POISON BY DEPARTMENTS AND OTHER STATE AGENCIES. No department, other state agency or person may use poison to kill predatory animals without first acquiring the written consent of the Board of Fish and Game.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
