AN ACT

Relating to the provision of human blood, and implied warranties under the Uniform Commercial Code.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 45.05.100 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(e) Implied warranties of merchantability and fitness shall not be applicable to a contract for the sale of human blood, blood plasma or other human tissue or organs from a blood bank or reservoir of tissue or organs. The blood, blood plasma, tissue, or organs shall not, for the purposes of secs. 36 - 242 of this chapter, be considered commodities subject to sale or barter, but shall be considered as medical services.
