AN ACT

Relating to the establishment of a program for assistance for housing and related facilities for Alaskans who are unable to finance such housing; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. The governor is authorized to prepare a state housing program for submission to the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development pursuant to Title 10, Section 1004, Public Law 89-754, 80 Stat. 1285 (1966). The program shall provide housing and related facilities for Alaskan residents in rural areas upon terms and conditions they can afford.

* Sec. 2. The program shall:

(1) specify the minimum and maximum standards for the housing and related facilities (not to exceed an average of \$7,500 per dwelling unit);

(2) to the extent feasible, encourage the proposed users of the housing and related facilities to utilize mutual and self-help in the construction thereof; and

(3) provide experience, and encourage continued participation, in self-government and individual home ownership.

* Sec. 3. The governor is authorized to designate an agency of the state or a public corporate authority of the state to carry out this program. The designated organization may accept grants or apply for and receive loans under Title 10, Section 1004(A), Public Law 89-754, 80 Stat. 1285 (1966).

* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
