## AN ACT

Authorizing relocation payments to persons displaced by highway construction; and providing for an effective date.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 19.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 19.05.045. RELOCATION PAYMENTS. In addition to the powers listed in sec. 40 of this chapter, the department is authorized to make relocation payments to a person who, or a family, business concern, farm, or nonprofit organization which is displaced by construction of a highway project. These relocation payments may not exceed \$200 in the case of an individual or family or \$3,000 in the case of a business concern (including the operation of a farm) or a nonprofit organization. In the latter cases if the business concern or organization moves more than 50 miles, the amount may not exceed the cost of moving 50 miles.

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
