HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 24

Extending greetings and congratulations to The Most Reverend Robert Lewis Whelan.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, The Most Reverend Robert Lewis Whelan, Society of Jesus, has been designated and appointed Coadjutor to the Bishop of the Diocese of Fairbanks, with the right of succession; and

WHEREAS, The Most Reverend Robert Lewis Whelan, Society of Jesus, has for many years diligently and faithfully served the spiritual interests of a large number of Alaskans while Pastor of the Cathedral Parish of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary at Juneau, and the Parish of Saint Anthony in Anchorage, which services are being fittingly recognized by his elevation to Episcopal status; and
