HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 26

Commending the Interior Airways of Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Interior Airways is presently providing three flights daily between Anchorage and Fairbanks thus providing better service and keener competition to the airlines industry; and

WHEREAS these services are being provided without the benefit of a federal government subsidy thus illustrating the dedication this airlines has in serving Alaska and Alaskans; and

WHEREAS these increased flights between Anchorage and Fairbanks will amount to no small contribution to the economy of our two largest cities;
