HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 27

Relating to the State's gratitude to the National Geographic Society.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the National Geographic Magazine has in the past featured many articles about Alaska and its people, including, in recent times, articles about the marine highway system (June 1965) and Alaskan Glaciers (February 1967); and

WHEREAS on February 7, 1967, it presented a one-hour nationwide television program about Alaska, and for the future is planning an article about flying in Alaska, and a book about Alaska and Canada; and

WHEREAS the National Geographic Society, through its excellent monthly magazine, has brought much attention to our state, has greatly increased the scientific knowledge about Alaska, and has undoubtedly increased the number of travelers to our state;

BE IT RESOLVED that this Resolution by the Fifth Legislature of the State of Alaska serve as an expression of gratitude to the National Geographic Society, and in particular to Mr. W.E. Garrett, who has been primarily involved, for their interest in and appreciation of the beauty and mystery of Alaska.
